\$100 chance to win \$10,000 drive is underway

Tickets are on sale for the club fundraiser, which will culminate with a gala celebration featuring food, beer and surprise entertainment at Treasures of Marilyn on November 17.

Chairman Chris Craven says the goal is to sell 300 tickets at \$100 each to raise funds for club projects and programs. The winner, who need not be present for the drawing, will receive \$10,000.

In addition, 10 recipients will win \$100 bills, thus paying for their contributions. The seller of the winning ticket will be rewarded with a Paul Harris Fellowship.

Craven said that if fewer than 200 tickets are sold, the fundraiser will be cancelled and contributions refunded.

Last year's inaugural fundraiser topped the \$30,000 goal.

Craven, who originated the fundraiser during his year as 2004-05 club president, said he is confident that the goal can be achieved again this year. He suggested that members stumped for sales prospects consider buying tickets for their children and grandchildren.
